



Dog - gie, dog - gie, where's your bone? Some - bod - y stole it
from your home. Doggie: Who has my bone? Student with bone: I have your bone.

- Game:
1. One student is the "doggie" in a chair facing away from the rest of the class.
 2. Students sing song while teacher hands one student a bone.
 3. "Doggie" sings "Who has my bone?" Student with the bone answers.
 4. "Doggie" has 3 guesses to figure out who sang.
 5. I choose 2 different students for the next round, no matter if the "doggie" guessed correctly or not.

Doggie, Doggie: Game Directions

GAME: Students sit in a circle on the floor.
One student chosen (by the teacher) to be "it,"
lies down in the middle of the circle and hides his/her eyes.
While the class sings the first line
of the song, the teacher appoints
someone sitting in the circle to "steal" the bone.
The thief returns to their place and
hides the bone behind their back
or some other appropriate place.
"It", with eyes still closed sings
"Who stole my bone?"
to which the thief must howl
or bark like a dog.
"It" gets three attempts to guess who
"stole" the bone.
The "thief" then becomes "it" and the
game is repeated many times with the
teacher choosing a different "thief" each time.

Other variations of text of song:

Doggie Doggie where's your bone?
Somebody took it from your home
Might be me, Might be you
Might be in your tennis shoe!

"Doggie, doggie where's your bone?
Somebody stole it from your home.
Guess who
Scooby doo!"

Doggy, doggy, where's your bone?
Somebody stole it from your home.
Guess who—maybe you!
Maybe the monkeys from the zoo!
