This is a traditional Sioux song. Pupils should sit in a circle with the teacher part of the circle. Tap knees to keep a regular pulse. Teach the words of the song first. The first phrase is repeated four times. The last phrase is a little tricky but will come with practice. The last two beats should be clapped. Repeat the song over and over again, speeding up gradually every time it is repeated.
