Game: Clump of children on one side of a room, the witch in the middle. All children sing mm. 1-4. The witch sings mm. 5-6; the children sing mm. 7-8. As the children shout the ending phrase, they try to run past the witch without being caught. The witch tags one person, and for the next round there are two witches, the following round four witches, and so forth, until everyone is caught. A new round begins with the last child caught as the new witch.
